INTRO

I Kings 10:1-7 - Queen of Sheba's spirit left her

Spirit = breath = ruach (Hebrew)

Sure enough, when the breath leaves, so does the spirit

Hebrew <> high tech language

Ruach = breath, spirit, wind, breeze, mind, etc.

Cool to think of HS as breath of God

Gen 2:7 - God breathed into Adam

Our life/breath comes from God

WHAT/WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT FROM OT?

Hebrew word ruach in many ways

Gen 1:2 – Spirit of God moving over the waters = ruach

Gen 3:8 – cool of the day = ruach

Gen 6:3 – Spirit of God = ruach

Gen 6:17 – breath of life = ruach

Gen 26:35 – mind = ruach

Gen 41:8 – Pharaoh's spirit (ruach) was troubled

God's ruach/spirit "comes on" someone

Num 11:24-29 – God pours out His Spirit on these elders and they prophesied

Num 24:2-6 – Spirit of God comes on Balaam and he sees things and prophesies

Num 27:18 – Joshua had "the" Spirit IN him

Judges 14:5-6 – Spirit of God comes on (rushes on) Samson and he kills a lion

II Chro 24:20 – Spirit of God comes on Zechariah

General

I Sam 10:6-7, 9-10 – Saul prophesies when he is anointed king

I Sam 19:20-21 – Saul sends people to prophesy against David

Jud 6:34 – the Spirit of the Lord came on Gideon and he delivered the people

Jud 14:5-6 – the Spirit of God comes on Samson to kill a lion with his bare hands

Jud 15:14-15 – the Spirit of the Lord comes on Samson who kills 1,000 with a jawbone

II Chro 20:14 – Spirit of the Lord in the whole congregation

II Chro 18:22 – a lying spirit can come from God

Psa 51:11 – do not take your Holy Spirit from me

Isa 42:1 – God's Spirit put upon Jesus

Messiah = Christ = anointed one

Isa 61:1 – the Spirit of the Lord is on me because He has anointed me

Isa 54:6 – human spirit same ruach as Holy Spirit of God

Isa 63:10 – people can cause the Holy Spirit to be troubled

Pushing away the Holy Spirit can make Him an enemy

Isa 63:11-14 – it was the Holy Spirit that led the Hebrews from Egypt

Eze 11:19-20 – God wants to put His Spirit in us and give us a heart of flesh, not stone

Also Eze 36:26-27

Eze 39:29 – God pours out His Holy Spirit on the people of Israel

Joel 2:28-29 – God promises to pour out His Spirit on all flesh

Isa 28:11 – stammering lips will bring rest

Acts 2:16-18 – Peter says Joel's prophecy is fulfilled here at Pentecost

HOLY SPIRIT IN NT

Spirit = Greek word pneuma

Mat 1:18 – Jesus' conception was "by" Holy Spirit

Ghost in KJV = spirit in modern English

Matt 3:11 – first reference to Baptism WITH the Holy Spirit

John's baptism nothing compared to baptism with the Holy Spirit

Matt 3:16 – Spirit of God coming down to rest on Jesus

Matt 4:1 – Holy Spirit leading Jesus just like He led prophets of old

Matt 8:16 – evil spirits use same word pneuma

Matt 10:20 – Holy Spirit called Spirit of the Father

A promise from Jesus that the same Holy Spirit that lead Him into the wilderness

Will lead us in times of trouble

Matt 12:26-28 – Jesus cast demons out by the Holy Spirit

Luke 11:20 says Jesus casts out demons by the Finger of God

So, Finger of God = Holy Spirit

Matt 12:31-32 – blasphemy against the Holy Spirit

Blasphemy = contemptuous/profane act, utterance or writing regarding something sacred

Vilification, especially against someone or something sacred

The act of claiming for oneself the attributes of God?

Matt 26:41 – seems to be talking about the human spirit?

Mark 1:8 – Jesus is the giver of the Holy Spirit

Mark 12:36 – Jesus explains that David was anointed by the Holy Spirit saying some things

Luke 1:15 – prophecy about Jesus being FILLED with the Holy Spirit

Christ = Greek for Anointed One, in Hebrew, Messiah means Anointed One

Luke 1:67 – filling with the Holy Spirit causes prophecy

Luke 2:25-27 – Simeon sounds like he was filled with the Holy Spirit and stayed that way

Luke 3:16 – Jesus will baptize with Holy Spirit and fire

What is the fire?

Luke 4:1 – Jesus was full of the Holy Spirit and led by same

Luke 4:14 – Jesus walked in the power of the Holy Spirit

Holy Spirit is not just for wisdom, knowledge, guidance

Luke 4:18 – the Spirit of the Lord was on Jesus to do many things

Reminds me of Jesus telling the disciples not to minister without filling of Holy Spirit

Luke 8:55 – New Testament example of spirit = breath = life

Luke 11:13 – Holy Spirit is given by the Father to those who ask

Context = Luke 11:5-

Luke 12:12 – a purpose of the Holy Spirit in us is to tell us what to say

Luke 24:39 – spirits do not have flesh and bones

Luke 24:49 – stay in Jerusalem until you be Spirit filled with power

John 1:32-33 – Spirit descends on Jesus at His baptism

Same Spirit that Jesus baptizes with

John 3:5-8 – we must be born of the Spirit

John 4:23-24 – true worshippers worship in Spirit and truth

John 7:39 – Holy Spirit not given because Jesus not resurrected

John 14:17 – Jesus said the Holy Spirit is living with them

John 14:26 – Holy Spirit = Comforter

John 15:26 – Holy Spirit = Spirit of Truth = testifies of Jesus

John 16:13 – Holy Spirit as a Revealer

John 16:5-7 – Jesus must leave so the Holy Spirit can come

John 20:22 – Jesus breathes on disciples and commands them to receive the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:4-8 – do not start your ministry until you have been Spirit baptized

Acts 4:8 – Peter’s actions informed by being filled with the Holy Spirit

Acts 4:31 – disciples refilled with the Holy Spirit

Acts 5:32 – Holy Spirit acts as a witness – how?

Acts 6:3 – qualification for ordaining deacons = full of the Holy Spirit

Not just acquainted with, or filled once before, but full now

Acts 7:51 – what did they do to resist the Holy Spirit?

Acts 13:2-4 – Holy Spirit active in sending ministers

How did the Holy Spirit say what He did to them?

Acts 13:9-11 – Paul was filled with the Holy Spirit = anointed to do wonders?

Acts 13:52 – disciples once again refilled with the Holy Spirit

Acts 15:28 – example of Holy Spirit active in church government

Acts 16:6-7 – if we are to preach everywhere, why forbid them to preach in Asia?

Acts 18:5 – what is being pressed in the Holy Spirit?

Acts 20:23 – another reference to the Holy Spirit witnessing

What is this?

Acts 20:28 – another example of the role of the Holy Spirit in church government

Acts 21:11 – example of the Holy Spirit speaking through a prophet

Rom 1:4 – what is this spirit of holiness?

Rom 2:29 – in the spirit = in the spirit realm?

Rom 5:5 – Holy Spirit brings us hope

Rom 8:1-2 – walking after the spirit = Holy Spirit?

How do we walk after the spirit?

Rom 15:19 – signs and wonders happen through the Holy Spirit

I Cor 2:4 – Holy Spirit demonstrates power

Signs and wonders and miracles?

I Cor 2:10-14 – inaction between God, Holy Spirit, and man’s spirit

I Cor 3:16 – we are the Temple of the Holy Spirit

I Cor 6:11 – Holy Spirit sanctifies us

Holy = set apart = sanctified

I Cor 6:19-20 – human body = temple for Holy Spirit

I Cor 7:40 – what does Paul mean, “I have the Spirit of God on this”?

I Cor 12:3-13 – spiritual gifts

Early church fathers expected some evidence of Spirit baptism

I Cor 14:2 – Speaking in tongues = speaking mysteries

I Cor 14:12-19 – speaking in tongues vs prophecy

II Cor 1:22 – Holy Spirit = seal = down payment for inheritance to come

Also II Cor 5:5

II Cor 3:16-17 – where the Spirit of the Lord is there is liberty

II Cor 4 – imitations of the Holy Spirit?

II Cor 13:14 – blessing that includes “communion of the Holy Spirit”

Gal 3:2-5 – Holy Spirit comes by hearing of faith

Gal 3:14 – promise of the Spirit = ?

Gal 4:5-6 – Holy Spirit allows us to call God Daddy

Gal 5:16-18, 25 – walk in the Spirit = ?

Gal 6:8-9 – sowing and reaping related to flesh and spirit

Eph 1:13-14 – sealed by the Holy Spirit = ?

Eph 1:17 – spirit = characteristic or Holy Spirit?

Eph 2:2 – spirit = characteristic or spirit of Satan?
Eph 2:22 – God is building His House by the Holy Spirit
His House = ?
Eph 3:5 – Holy Spirit working through Apostles and Prophets
Eph 4:2-4 – only one Holy Spirit?
Eph 4:30 – how might the Holy Spirit be grieved?
Eph 5:9 – fruit of the Spirit
Eph 5:18 – comparing being drunk with being Holy Spirit filled
Eph 6:17-18 – sword of the Holy Spirit = the Bible
Phil 3:3 – worshipping God in the Spirit
Col 1:8 – how is God’s love declared in the Spirit?
I Thes 1:5 – is this a list of 3 things or three synonyms?
I Thes 4:8 – He gave us His Holy Spirit
I Thes 5:19 – quench not the Holy Spirit - ??
II Thes 2:8 – the Spirit of God’s mouth - ??
II Thes 2:13 – sanctification of the Holy Spirit - ??
II Tim 1:7 – God has not given us a spirit of fear
II Tim 1:14 – keep that good thing by the Holy Spirit
Titus 3:5 – renewing of the Holy Spirit
Heb 2:4 – gifts of the Holy Spirit – a list or synonyms?
Heb 6:4-6 – impossible to restore those who have tasted and fallen away
Jam 4:5 – the Holy Spirit lusts to envy - ??
I Pet 1:2 – sanctification of the Spirit
II Pet 1:21 – OT prophecy from the Holy Spirit
I John 3:24, 4:13 – we know He lives in us by the Spirit He has given us
I John 5:7 – doctrine of the trinity?
Jude 1:20 – praying in the Holy Spirit
Rev 1:10, 4:2 – in the Spirit on the Lord’s Day - ??

HOLY SPIRIT BAPTISM

John 16:5-7 – Jesus must leave so the Holy Spirit can come

Mark 1:8 – Jesus is the giver of the Holy Spirit

Luke 11:11-13 – Jesus gives the Holy Spirit to those who ask

Luke 24:49 – stay in Jerusalem until you be Spirit filled with power

Acts 1:4-8 – do not start your ministry until you have been Spirit baptized

I Cor 3:16 – we are the Temple of the Holy Spirit

Acts 5:15-16 – Peter's shadow heals people

Acts 19:11-12 – Paul sends out healing clothes

Acts 2:1-4 – first people to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit

Acts 8:14-19 – Samaritans receive the Holy Spirit

Acts 9:15-19 – Paul is baptized in the Holy Spirit

I Cor 14:18 – Paul thanks God he speaks in tongues the most

Acts 10:24-27, 34-35, 44-47 – First Gentiles receive the Holy Spirit

Acts 11:15-18 – Peter concludes the Gentiles were saved

Acts 19:1-7 – Ephesians receive Holy Spirit after being saved

I Cor 12:8-10 – early church fathers expected some evidence of Spirit baptism

JESUS THE EXAMPLE OF LIVING A SPIRIT FILLED LIFE

John 2:32-34 – Jesus' baptism and filling with the Holy Spirit

John was told to look for the coming Messiah

And he would know who was Messiah by this sign

The Holy Spirit would come to rest on Him and stay on/with Him

Now today, when that happens to someone

We call it being filled with the Holy Spirit or being baptized in the Holy Spirit

Jesus told His disciples to expect a similar experience after His resurrection

John 14:16-17 – Jesus will send the Holy Spirit to live in them

Not just with them

I think that Jesus was our example of a Spirit-filled man living on this earth

He is telling them here that He wanted this for His followers, too

Notice that Jesus did not start His ministry until after the Holy Spirit came on Him

He tells His followers the **THEY** should **NOT** start their ministry

Until after they have been filled with the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:4-5, 8 – Jesus last commands to His disciples

Wait for the Holy Spirit baptism before starting to minister to others

When you receive the Holy Spirit, you will receive power

Mark 16:17-18 – Jesus' expectation for believers

This, too, is right before Jesus ascended into Heaven

He is describing the normal life of the normal believer

He is describing a life of power where He expects every believer to

Lay hands on the sick and see them recover

Story of getting people in line to pray for sick for first time

Story of teenager praying for Jackie who was healed of cancer

Cast out demons

Story of incubus spirit

Speak in tongues

Not be subject to poisons (see Acts 28:3-6)

This is my contention

Jesus wants all we believers to walk in the same miraculous power that He walked in

But the only way we can do that is the way He did it

By first being filled to overflowing with the Holy Spirit of God

Let's look at what happened to the early believers

And what happened to them when the Holy Spirit fell on them

BAPTISM/FILLING/INDWELLING OF HOLY SPIRIT IN ACTS

Baptism = immersion in water = baptisma (Greek)

Simple languages means washing a cup = baptism of the cup

Church use eventually gave it special meaning of religious significance

Terms used = baptized, filled, received, indwelt (lived in)

Isa 57:15 – God wants to live inside humble and contrite people

Part of His desire to live in us is to comfort and revive us

Holy Spirit baptisms and demonstrations in the book of Acts

Sometimes called acts of the Apostles

Maybe should be called the acts of the Holy Spirit

Acts 2:1-11 – first outpouring of the Holy Spirit

Pentecost is Greek for the Hebrew word Shavuot

Shavuot is the celebration of God giving Torah on Mt Sinai

How fitting that God would pour out His Holy Spirit on all mankind

At the celebration of God pouring out the Law on the Jews

Acts 2:17-18, 33 – Peter claims this experience is a fulfillment of Joel's prophecy

Acts 2:38 – Peter expects everyone who gets saved to "receive" the Holy Spirit

Acts 3:1-8 – Peter tells this crippled man that he has something better than money

What Peter had was the Holy Spirit in Him

Just like the Spirit on Moses was distributed to the elders

Acts 4:7-8 – when they asked Peter how he did this miracle

Acts 4:29-31 – disciples refilled with Holy Spirit

Acts 5:15-16 – Peter's shadow heals people

Acts 8:14-19 – Samaritans receive the Holy Spirit

Acts 9:15-19 – Paul is baptized in the Holy Spirit

Acts 10:24-27, 34-35, 44-47 – First Gentiles receive the Holy Spirit

Acts 11:15-18 – Peter concludes the Gentiles were saved

Acts 13:8-11 – Paul also worked miracles because he was already filled with the Spirit

Acts 18:24-26 – Apollos taught a "more accurate way" about baptism

Acts 19:1-7 – Ephesians receive Holy Spirit after being saved

Acts 19:11-12 – Paul sends out healing clothes

Why not speak in tongues?

I Cor 14:4 – speaking in tongues is a personal gift to build up the speaker

Isa 28:11 – stammering lips will bring rest

Jude 20 – praying in the Spirit builds up our faith

I Cor 14:18 – Paul spoke in tongues more than all the Corinthians combined

Real men serve God

Real men have a vibrant, daily, deep relationship with Jesus

Real men allow the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow through them

People say that sissies serve God (know what a sissy is?)

My contention is that it takes a strong and courageous man to server God

And to show gentleness and love to his family

Let me share some experiences with you as a man

Story of putting family through 3 years of financial pain

Story of teaching Sandy how to do spiritual warfare riding a bicycle

Now that she is grown and has 4 children of her own

This has turned out to be an invaluable skill

Story of Sandy and family moving into a new house

A spirit of fear in the new house began to paralyze Sandy

Her first daughter Hannah started being demonized

Hannah would get this wild look in her eyes that terrified Sandy

The Holy Spirit revealed to Sandy and her husband

That they were being attacked by demons in their new house

Some missionary friends of ours helped us do a home blessing for them

Once we all agreed together and drove off those demons in Jesus' Name

Everything calmed down in their house – and with Hannah, too

Sandy was telling me that this has become second nature now

My wife also taught our daughter how to tattle to God on her husband

When they think we men are about to make a bad decision

They do not argue with us

But go to God and “tell” on their husband

You have heard children say, “I’m going to tell on you”

When they do that, God protects us from making bad decisions

Teach your wives and daughters to do this

Story of children praying for healing of Aedan’s finger
